Singapore has four official languages, including English. Most people in Singapore can speak two languages. Many parts of Asia are polluted, poor and crowded, but Singapore is one of the wealthier(より豊かな) countries in the region(地域). Singapore is a small island country, situated south of Malaysia. Like other countries in this region, it has a tropical climate — dry and hot for part of the year, warm and rainy for the rest of the year.

The diversity(多様性) of food is a reason to visit the country, and the variety of food representing(代表する) different countries is seen by the government as a symbol of its multiculturalism(多文化性). Chinese, Malay, and Indian food are very common. One popular dish is Hainanese chicken and rice. Since Singapore is an island, seafood is common, too. Western food, including Australian food, is becoming more popular, as well(~もまた).



It's difficult to name(名前をあげる) another world city that boasts(~を誇る) as many eco-attractions as Singapore. Eco-attractions are places that are friendly to the environment, like



parks. Singapore has many public spaces and the city is always building more. There are the <u>Botanic Gardens</u>(植物園) and Gardens by the Bay(湾). In Gardens by the Bay, there are <u>huge manmade trees</u>(巨大な人工の木々). Real plants grow on the manmade trees.
